- d. Teen Pregnancies are down. Praise God. More than half of babies born are to single parents.
- e. 40% increase in Oregon drug overdose death... protection of our people from temptation
- f. Depression, Suicide (sudden increase 7, 2 homocides), overdosing on drugs (common).
- g. 9 Total Abortions this year. (Big decrease) Sept. 13 Supreme Court to hear cases against abortion
- 4. Family: Restore divisions in families. Strengthen bonds of loyalty.
  - a. Protection and deliverance from isolation, depression, addictions and domestic violence
  - b. Homelessness, Poverty, Jobs, Expensive Rent

#### 5. Business:

- a. 10 Marijuana Shops in Tillamook Co.
- b. Restoration of Businesses suffering during COVID: Restaurants, Tourism, small businesses
- c. Stable supply lines and adequate employees to maintain business.
- d. Housing Rental Solutions
- e. Financial stability...help people to shop locally
- f. Best service employees honorable giving a fair day of work, excellent service, teamwork, cause businesses to shine! Praise! Unemployment down to 4.7% in July (down from 5.9)
- g. Tourism and fishing to rebound with prosperity. Disease in oyster beds- businesses have closed.
