PRAY FOR:

Our Country, State and County are in crisis. This month let us focus on healing

1. The Church:
 - a. Help us to minister to those who have lost family members and to those who are sick.
 - b. Help US, the Church reach out effectively to those hurting, fearful and lonely.
 - c. Strengthen the Church to LOVE like You have loved us.
 - d. We are seeing families, friends and churches divided with hatred and fear over the COVID vaccines and politics, destroying the very fabric that makes our people reel with contempt for one another. **Pray for forgiveness and restoration of these vital relationships.**
 - e. We pray protection over THE CHURCH, to take a reasonable and bold stand and not bow down to pressure and loss of our freedoms.
2. Education:
 - a. Pray for our School Boards to have wisdom and to make decisions which will be healthy for the children and to provide a structure conducive to learning. We pray protection over those who honor the Lord in their decision making. Give them strength. Remove those goading against You.
 - b. Let all the parents and counties rise up against bad laws. Let them honor our great nation. One Nation, Under God, Indivisible, with Liberty and Justice for ALL! Establish a precedent of righteousness in the push back.
 - c. Give parents a boldness and a say in their children's education. We bind up labeling parents as "terrorists." Help them articulate and resist indoctrination of our children in the ways of the world.
 - d. Transparency of curriculum content.
 - e. Curriculum: Let the curriculum honor God, truth and history, build skills for life, help build capable leaders and strong foundations. Help parents speak up regarding Critical Race Theory and Marxist ideology and other philosophies which go against God's Word and the welfare of the students.
 - f. We pray for ALL children going back to school to re-engage in learning, protection and liberty in the joy of discovery. We pray for the Church schools that are starting.
 - g. We pray for teachers who are being laid off due to school vaccine mandates. Provide them a place to teach and bring curriculum excellence, love to the kids.
3. Health Care:
 - a. Protect us from variant strains of COVID. To date: 1949cases, 29 deaths
 - b. Staffing of nurses and other medical professions is at crisis levels making hospital beds unavailable
 - c. Protection of medical, nursing, paramedics and ancillary staff.
 - d. Teen Pregnancies are down. Praise God. More than half of babies born are to single parents.
 - e. 40% increase in Oregon drug overdose death... protection of our people from temptation
 - f. Depression, Suicide (sudden increase 7, 2 homicides), overdosing on drugs (common).
 - g. 9 Total Abortions this year. (Big decrease) Sept. 13 Supreme Court to hear cases against abortion
4. Family: **Restore divisions in families. Strengthen bonds of loyalty.**
 - a. **Help families who are not vaccinated navigate employment. Let there be more than enough work with money sufficient to meet the rising costs.**
 - b. **Protection and deliverance from isolation, depression, addictions and domestic violence**
 - c. **Homelessness, Poverty, Jobs, Expensive Rent**
5. Business:
 - a. **10 Marijuana Shops in Tillamook Co.**
 - b. **Help business owners navigate the issues of Mandates and maintain their workforce.**
 - c. **Restoration of Businesses suffering during COVID: Restaurants, Tourism, small businesses**
 - d. **Stable supply lines and adequate employees to maintain business.**

- h. Tourism and fishing to rebound with prosperity. Disease in oyster beds- businesses have closed.
- 6. Government:
 - a. Oregon State Rep. Suzanne Weber and David Gomberg Suzanne Weber is running for State Senate!
 - b. Oregon State Senators: Betsy Johnson and Dick Anderson Betsy J. is running for Governor!
 - c. County Commissioners: David Yamamoto, Mary Faith Bell, Erin Skarr
 - d. County Leadership: Wisdom, strength, endurance to deal with many issues.
 - e. Your City, County & State Leadership: (Pray for leaders in your city -page 3), Wisdom, unity, work as a team, favor with the people
