PRAY FOR:

1. The Church:

- a. Let the Church be AWAKE! Let the Church carry a torch of LOVE! Let every Believer begin to share the good news!
- b. Help US, the Church be lovers of TRUTH from Your Word.
- c. Strengthen the Church to LOVE our cities like You have loved us.
- d. We are seeing families, friends and churches divided with hatred and fear over the COVID vaccines and policies. Pray for forgiveness and restoration of these vital relationships.
- e. We pray protection over THE CHURCH, to take a reasonable and bold stand and not bow to pressure and loss of our freedoms. Wise as serpents, gentle as doves

2. Education:

- a. Pray for Neakahnie, Tillamook and Nestucca School Boards to discern, have wisdom and to make decisions which will be healthy for our children and to provide a structure conducive to learning. - b. Let our parents take an active role in advocating for education. . Help parents speak up regarding philosophies which go against God's Word.

- b. Staffing of nurses and other medical professions is at crisis levels making hospital beds unavailable. Protection for health care workers.
- c. Kilchis House and Nehalem Bay House are closing. Placement for residents
- d. Teen Pregnancies 3 in 2021. 77% of babies born are to single parents.
- e. 40% increase in Oregon drug overdose death... protection of our people from temptation. Drugs are being cut with other lethal products.
- f. Depression, Suicide (sudden increase 11 suicides in 2021, 2 homicides), overdosing on drugs (common).
- g. 14 Total Abortions 2021. (Big decrease) Pray for Supreme Court Justices and their clerks. Will deliver ruling to overturn Roe at the end of June.

4. Family: Restore divisions in families. Strengthen bonds of loyalty and peace.

- a. Help families who are not vaccinated navigate employment. Let there be more than enough work with money sufficient to meet the rising costs.
- b. Protection and deliverance from isolation, depression, addictions and domestic violence
- c. Homelessness, Poverty, Jobs, Expensive Rent

- c. Restoration of Businesses: Its time for them to flourish! Restaurants, Tourism, small businesses
- d. Stable supply lines and adequate employees to maintain business.
- e. Housing Rental Solutions. New apartment complex approved.
- f. Financial stability...help people to shop locally
- g. Best service – honorable employees giving a fair day of work, excellent service, teamwork, cause businesses to shine! Praise! Unemployment down to 3.6% in November. 430 (Nov.) people on unemployment.
- h. Tourism and fishing to rebound with prosperity. Disease in oyster beds to be healed- businesses have closed.

6. Government:

- a. Oregon State Rep. Suzanne Weber and David Gomberg Suzanne Weber is running for State Senate!
- b. Oregon State Senators: Betsy Johnson and Dick Anderson Betsy J. is running for Governor!

- d. County Leadership: Wisdom, strength, endurance to deal with many issues.

- f. Wisdom and boldness to go against the flow on “State Mandates”
