- e. 40% increase in Oregon drug overdose death... protection of our people from temptation. Drugs are being cut with other lethal products.
- f. Depression, Suicide (sudden increase 11 suicides in 2021, 2 homicides), overdosing on drugs (common).
- g. 34 Total Abortions 2021 (this is up from last year). Pray for Supreme Court Justices and their clerks. Will deliver ruling to overturn Roe at the end of June.

## 4. Family: Restore divisions in families. Strengthen bonds of loyalty and peace.

- a. Help families who are not vaccinated navigate employment. Let there be more than enough work with money sufficient to meet the rising costs.
