- e. Depression, Suicide (sudden increase 11 suicides in 2021, 2 homicides), overdosing on drugs (common).
- f. 34 Total Abortions 2021 (this is up from last year). Pray for Supreme Court Justices and their clerks. Will deliver ruling to overturn Roe at the end of June.
- 4. Family: Restore divisions in families. Strengthen bonds of loyalty and peace.
  - a. Help families who are not vaccinated navigate employment. Let there be more than enough work with money sufficient to meet the rising costs.
  - b. Protection and deliverance from isolation, depression, addictions and domestic violence
  - c. Homelessness Estimate 2019 of 184 people , Poverty, Jobs, Expensive Rent
