- e. Depression, 2 Suicides in first quarter (better than last year) (sudden increase 11 suicides in 2021, 2 homicides), overdosing on drugs (common).
- f. 7 Abortions in the first quarter of 2022. Overturned Roe Vs Wade!!! Pray for State of Oregon who has opened doors and funding to anyone wanting abortion without restriction.

4. Family: Restore divisions in families. Strengthen bonds of loyalty and peace.

- a. Presence of God: Flood our homes with the Presence of God. Let there be an explosion of revelation of goodness and leading families with love, strength, discipline, compassion.
