PRAY FOR:

1. The Church:

- a. Awakening: Let the Church be AWAKE! Let the Church carry a torch of LOVE! Let every Believer begin to share the good news.
- b. Let strong, righteous Believers take positions of leadership in every sphere of culture
- c. Discipleship: Let every new Believer get planted and growing in the Body of Christ, strengthened to fight the good fight of faith, reproducing new Believers.
- d. Let Believers have a biblical world view rather than a world view.
- e. Strengthen the Church to LOVE our cities and people and neighbors like You have loved us.
- f. Let Believers come together to PRAY for Oregon and our people,
- g. Protection: We pray protection over THE CHURCH, to take a reasonable and bold stand and not bow to pressure. Wise as serpents, gentle as doves.
- h. Let our pastors and Churches love and respect each other and take time together. Open Kingdom gates for the Coastal Prayer Summit.

2. Education:

- a. Pray for Neakahnie, Tillamook and Nestucca School Boards to discern, have wisdom and to make decisions which will be healthy for our children and to provide a structure conducive to learning. Let our children LEARN and have a firm education to build on. Give perseverance to graduate.
- b. We pray for healthy and stable family life for every child, with adequate support & supervision.

3. Health Care:

- a. Staffing of nurses and other medical professions is at crisis levels making hospital beds unavailable. (Continues to be a problem). Part of the problem is housing.
- b. Teen Pregnancies 0 in 10-17 age, 4 in 18-19 age in 2022. Of all babies born, 43.2% are born are to single parents (lower).
- c. 2021 40% increase in Oregon drug overdose death... protection of our people from temptation. Drugs are being cut with other lethal products. Overthrow bad drug laws!
- d. Depression, 5 Suicides in third quarter (better than last year) (sudden increase 11 suicides in 2021, 2 homicides), overdosing on drugs (common in 2021, better this year).
- e. 20 Abortions in the third quarter of 2022. Overturned Roe Vs Wade!!! Pray for State of Oregon who has opened doors and funding to anyone wanting abortion without restriction.

4. Family: Restore divisions in families. Strengthen bonds of loyalty and peace.

- a. Presence of God: Flood our homes with the Presence of God. Let there be an explosion of revelation of goodness and leading families with love, strength, discipline, compassion.

- b. Inflation 8.38% increase in 2022: Let there be more than enough work with money sufficient to meet the rising costs. 435 unemployed or 4.0% of Tillamook Co..
- c. Protection and deliverance from isolation, depression, addictions and domestic violence. Put a desire to go to church and help the churches be equipped to minister effectively to help.
- d. Homelessness Estimate 2019 of 184 people in Tillamook Co. , Poverty, Jobs
- e. Housing shortages /Expensive Rent

5. Business: Current Unemployment rate is 4%

- a. Healthy, holy family values to prevail in all businesses: Tillamook Co. Marijuana sales are #6 in the state. \$343 avg./per resident!
- b. Main Street beginning to remodel and renovate.
- c. Stabilize Inflation and supply lines and adequate employees to maintain business.
- d. Housing Rental Solutions. Need more housing for potential employees.
- e. Financial stability...help people to shop locally. Praise: Many new, attractive shops!
- f. Tourism and fishing to rebound .with prosperity. Disease in oyster beds to be healed- businesses have closed.

6. Government:

- a. Election Integrity at every level in Tillamook Co, Oregon and National
- b. Oregon State Rep. Suzanne Weber and David Gomberg, Suzanne Weber is running for State Senate!
- c. Oregon State Senators: Rachel Armitage and Dick Anderson,
- d. County Commissioners: David Yamamoto, Mary Faith Bell, Erin Skarr
- e. County Leadership: Wisdom, strength, endurance to deal with many issues.
- f. Your City, County & State Leadership: (Pray for leaders in your city -page 3,4 Wisdom, unity, work as a team, favor with the people, accomplish God's purposes to meet city needs.
